2025 Chinese Government Scholarship

Silk Road Program

The Chinese Government Scholarship "Silk Road Program" is a fully funded scholarship program by the Ministry of Education of China, used by some Chinese universities to independently recruit outstanding international students to study in China. This project aims to select international students with excellent academic backgrounds, professional abilities, and development potential to pursue bachelor's, master's and doctor's degrees at our university. According to the relevant documents of the Ministry of Education and in combination with the actual situation of the university, this brochure is specially formulated as follows:

I. Eligibility

1. Be a citizen from countries of "Belt & Road" program such as Thailand, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Bangladesh, Nepal, Uzbekistan, Pakistan, etc., and be in good health both mentally and physically.
2. Age and Education Background:
 - graduated from higher secondary school under the age of 25 when applying for bachelor's programs;
 - be a bachelor's degree holder under the age of 35 when applying for master's programs;
 - be a master's degree holder under the age of 40 when applying for doctoral programs;
3. Have acquired the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 4 when applying for Chinese-taught master's or doctoral programs;

4. Applicants for professional degrees to pursue master's or doctoral degrees. Chinese proficiency must reach HSK Level 4 of the Chinese Proficiency Test (HSK)
5. All bachelor's degree programs are taught in Chinese medium only; candidates must acquire the Chinese proficiency of HSK Level 3 or above when applying. Those who haven't met Chinese proficiency requirements shall attend additional Chinese language course till they obtain HSK Level 4, otherwise they are not eligible to join professional study.
6. Meet the admission requirements of the applied universities in terms of academic ability, language proficiency and other relevant criteria.

II. Type of Scholarship

1. Type of Students:

Full time Bachelor's Master's and Doctor's degree students.

2. Duration of Scholarship:

4 -5 years for Bachelor's Degree students;

3 years for Master's Degree students,

3 - 4 years for Doctor's Degree students.

3. Content of Scholarship:

- (1). Covers tuition fee;

- (2). Covers hostel fee;

- (3). Covers the comprehensive insurance during the period of time studying in China;

- (4). Covers living expenses during the period of time studying in China:

RMB 2500 yuan for Bachelor's degree students

RMB 3000 yuan for Master's degree students.

RMB 3500 yuan for Doctor's degree students.

III. Language

Bachelor's degree programs: Chinese medium only

Master's and Doctor's degree programs: Chinese or English medium.

IV. Application Procedure

1. Applicants are required to complete online-application on the CSC System by visiting the website <https://www.campuschina.org>, to register and fill applications online. The **Agent Number of Kunming Medical University is 10678 and please choose Program Category "Type B"** .
2. Applicants log in to the "Kunming Medical University Study Abroad Management Information System" (website address: <https://kmmc.17gz.org/>) Register an account, fill in the application information, and submit the relevant attachments. Applicants for professional degree graduate programs must provide proof of HSK level 4 or above (valid for two years), otherwise they can only apply for academic degree graduate programs.

V. Application Deadline

25 April 2025 — 11 May 2025

VI. Application Documents

1. Copy of Passport Home Page. Passport shall have more than six-month validity (expire after November 2025);
2. Notarized highest diploma and degree certificate. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations;
3. Academic transcripts (from the undergraduate program onwards). Copies of academic records from first to last semester during the undergraduate, graduate (if any), and doctoral programs (if any) shall be provided. These transcripts shall be issued and sealed by the attending university's academic affairs office, graduate school, or student management department. They can be in Chinese or English, but must be attached with notarized English translations if they are in foreign languages other than English;
4. Language qualification certificates. Applicants for Chinese-taught programs must submit valid HSK reports (2-year valid) in accordance with the corresponding Chinese proficiency requirements.

Applicants for programs taught in English medium shall provide English proficiency certificates according to the universities' requirements, like IELTS or TOFEL report;

*Remarks: Applicants for professional degree graduate programs must provide valid HSK4 or above. Otherwise, they can only apply for academic degree graduate programs.

5. A study or research plan proposal. A study plan written in Chinese or English shall contain more than 1,000 characters or words;

6. Recommendation letters. Two letters of recommendation (written only in Chinese or English) from professors or associate professors shall be submitted (for bachelor's degree candidates, two letters signed by teachers of previous school). These letters shall describe the applicant's objectives of learning in China, comprehensive abilities, and evaluation of future growth, as well as the cooperation between the supervisors or the exchange between universities both in China and abroad;

7. A valid Foreigner Physical Examination Form completed in English or Chinese (the original copy shall be kept by the applicant). The form is designed by the Chinese quarantine authority and can be obtained from the dispatching authority. The physical examinations must cover all the items listed in the Foreigner Physical Examination Form. Incomplete records or those without the signature of the attending physician, the official stamp of the hospital, or a sealed photograph of the applicants are invalid. Please select the appropriate time to take a physical examination as the result is valid for only 6 months.

8. Non-criminal record report (6-month valid). The applicant shall submit a valid certificate of Non-Criminal Record issued by the local public security authority, usually issued within 6 months prior to the submission date of the application.

Attention:

1. Everything to be uploaded to the online application system must be clear, true, and valid. It is suggested to use professional scan devices to make soft copies to upload. In case of not clear copies, applicants shall be responsible for the consequences and **the university will not receive any hard copies from applicants.**
2. Admission materials will be sent to the personal email address listed in the communication section. According to relevant national regulations, paper materials will no longer be mailed.
3. When registering at the university after enrollment, applicants shall bring all the application

documents to the university. (true graduation certificates are required rather than pre-graduation certificate)

4. The university will not authorize any personnel or agents to recruit students for CSC scholarship. If you have any questions, please contact the university directly.

VII. Admission Procedure

1. Applicants are required to complete online-application on the CSC System by visiting the website <https://www.campuschina.org>, to register and fill applications online. The **Agent Number of Kunming Medical University is 10678 and please choose Program Category "Type B"** .
2. Applicants log in to the "Kunming Medical University Study Abroad Management Information System" (website address: <https://kmmc.17gz.org/>) Register an account, fill in the application information, and submit the relevant attachments. Applicants for professional degree graduate programs must provide proof of HSK level 4 or above (valid for two years), otherwise they can only apply for academic degree graduate programs.
3. Applicants who have passed the initial review of application materials will be reviewed by school professors and participate in relevant online video interviews.
4. The admission results of the Chinese Government Scholarship "Silk Road" project will be notified to the admitted individuals through the "Chinese Government Scholarship Study in China Management Information System" (<https://www.campuschina.org>) and email. Applicants are requested to check their email and registration website for relevant information in real time.

VIII. Others

1. The admission results of the Chinese Government Scholarship "Silk Road" project will be notified to the admitted individuals through the "Chinese Government Scholarship Study in China Management Information System" (<https://www.campuschina.org>) and email.

Applicants are requested to check their email and registration website for relevant information in real time.

2. Admitted students shall register at the university according to the required date with the said application documents as well as the documents of admission decisions. Students who cannot register at the university within the date shall apply to postpone the registration date with formal written letters in no more than two weeks (counting from the registration date). Those who do not ask for leave or whose leave expires, will be regard as giving up their qualifications to study in the university.
3. Students who bear the scholarship shall attend the annual assessment carried out by the university. Those who are absent or fail in the assessment will have their scholarship paused or cancelled.
4. Students of CSC scholarship are ineligible for other scholarship (except the one-time bonus or awards). Once being found for such case, CSC scholarship will be cancelled and the issued money must be returned to the university. Those who conceal the fact will not be allowed to apply the scholarship again within three years except for the cancellation of scholarship qualification.
